Academic Change Form:

Students Remaining in or Switching into Rosenstiel

This form is to request a change of Academic Plan (major) within the same College/School, or Academic Program (change to a different Academic College/School) or add/remove a minor. Students **MUST** consult with an academic advisor before completing. Certain colleges have entrance requirements. Be sure that you have met all requirements required by the college you wish to change to before submitting.

Requirements for transferring to the Rosenstiel School with no GPA:

1. If a student does not have a GPA, we will not accept them into the program until after the student's final grades are posted.

*Although students will be unable to change majors, we can aid students in enrolling in MSC 111 and 112. It will be the student's responsibility to provide the desired section that they wish to be enrolled in and send this information to <u>marsci@miami.edu</u>.

2. Once the final grades are posted, students are required to meet with the director of the program to review program expectations.

*Please refer to the list of Rosenstiel directors. If you are unable to get in contact with a Rosenstiel director, please email <u>marsci@miami.edu</u>.

3. If approved, students will be assigned an academic advisor by the director. The advisor's name should be provided on the academic change form under the primary major.

4. Once the student has met with the director and been assigned an academic advisor the previous home school can submit the form to <u>marsci@miami.edu</u> for further processing. Our office will only be accepting <u>digital forms</u>.

Requirements for transferring to the Rosenstiel School with a GPA:

- BS programs require a 2.5 UM GPA, 3.0 preferred, or acceptance by the director BA programs require a 2.25 or acceptance by the director
- 2. Meet with the director of the program to review program expectations.

If you are an **international student** be sure to discuss your requested changes with your ISSS advisor and obtain their signature.
